2 INTRODUCTION

Fencing Fox is an easy-to-use modern software to manage small as well as large fencing competitions. It comes with a companion software Diaporama to display results on screens.

3 INSTALLATION

The Fencing Fox software (software for short) runs on Windows, Linux or Mac OS. To run the software, just enter the license number. Be careful to be connected to Internet when entering the license number the first time, then it will no more be necessary. The license is attached a computer. Some firewall configurations will require you to accept connections for the Fencing Fox software at the operating system management level.

The **Diaporama** may sit on a different computer than the computer that runs the FencingFox app, and the diaporama itself does not need a license to run. It can be copied on several computers, including SOCs like Raspberry Pi. It may use any operating system. It might be necessary to open some ports in your firewall.

It is now possible to have the same functionality embedded in the software, with the constraint on sitting on the same computer, by launching the Menu **Tournament/Diaporama**.

3.1 INSTALLING ON WINDOWS

On Windows, just decompress the file FencingFoxSetup.zip and double click on the executable file to start installation. Then open the Diaporama.exe program.

You can copy the Diaporama.exe to another computer since it does not require a licence, but you must copy the dlls as well.

3.2 INSTALLING ON MAC OS

Download the **DiaporamaFinal.pkg** file. Double click to start the installation process.

3.3 INSTALLING ON LINUX (AND RASPBERRY)

The diaporama uses sqlite and libcairo libraries.

Libcairo is usually already installed, to install sqlite use the following :

sudo apt-get install sqlite3

Uncompress the tarball. You can use the command line with:

tar xvzf diaporama.tar.gz

Check the run.sh command is executable using:

chmod u+x run.sh

Then run :

./run.sh

3.4 UPGRADING

During the validity of the license, usually one year, you may download new versions in the same directory as the existent software at any time.

3.5 UNINSTALLING

To uninstall, just remove the install directory.

4 LAUNCHING THE DIAPORAMA

The diaporama can be launched as a separate application or inside Fencing Fox main software. Several instances may run on several computers and connect to the same software.

4.1 STARTING INSIDE FENCING FOX

Just use the **Tournament/Diaporama** menu or click on the Diaporama icon in the toolbar.



The diaporama may use different screens connected to the computer.

4.2 STARTING A SEPARATE APPLICATION

The diaporama program may reside on a distant computer or on the same computer as Fencing Fox. Many diaporamas may connect to the same Fencing Fox.

4.2.1 STARTING THE SERVICE IN FENCING FOX

For Fencing Fox to listen to any diaporama, you must start the service in Fencing Fox using **Tournament/Service** menu and clicking on **Start** next to the Diaporama Service.

The IP address next to the service must be the Fencing Fox local network interface used for networking with the Diaporamas. For instance, if the diaporamas are connected using wifi, the address must be the wifi address. Same for Ethernet.

The Packets checkbox is used only for hit by hit display of pistes.

4.2.2 CONNECTING A DIAPORAMA TO FENCING FOX

You must connect even if you are on the same computer. To connect a diaporama to Fencing Fox, you must enter:

1) The **Diaporama local address** on the same network as Fencing Fox (for instance wifi address if connected using wifi)

- 2) The **Fencing Fox remote address** on the same network as the Diaporama or **localhost** if it is on the same computer
- 3) Click on **Connect**

A list of competitions **active** in Fencing Fox will be displayed as tabs, here EDS, N1eq, N2eq and 2017-7. On the right you may edit general parameters.

4.2.3 CONNECTING AND DISCONNECTING

Important notice: if you reset the Tournament in Fencing Fox, or if you load a new tournament, you must disconnect and reconnect the Diaporamas.

5 COMMON PARAMETERS

5.1 MANAGING FONTS AND LOGOS

Fonts and logos are managed at the global level. Click on the **Global** tab to view the property panel in the right window panel.

The global property panel allows to select fonts for all pages, as well as the logo displayed in the left part.

These parameters are shared by all screens.

- The tournament name is displayed in the first title line.
- The logo is displayed on the left. The software adapts the logo size, but it is recommended to have an almost square logo. The displayed size will be 4 times the title font size.

The tournament title can also be modified without modifying the tournament title in Fencing Fox. If the title has been modified in Fencing Fox, click on **Reset** to get it (otherwise the local value will supersede the root value).

Use the button to select the logo which must be in png format.

Apply to all will apply the properties to all created pages.

5.2 MANAGING COLORS

Colors can be managed at the competition level. Click on any competition tab to display the parameters in the right window panel.

This competition property window will allow to modify the competition title, to modify the colors for text, title, line and background.

The competition title is displayed on the second line of screen headers.

To modify a color, either select a predefined set of colors in the right collection of buttons,



or select individually each color by clicking in the color rectangle.

A color selection window will appear to select according to hue, saturation and value.



It is also possible to enter an HTML value like #409FFF.

Apply to all will apply the new parameters to all the competition pages.

Generate creates a list of standard screens usually used by a competition: participants, poules, tables and ranking.

5.3 ERROR MESSAGES

Error messages are displayed in orange at the top of the window. Be careful to read these messages if the launch does not work.

6 CREATING DIAPORAMA PAGES

There is large panel of possibilities to display information on screens.

Here is a complete list:



The data are pushed in real time from the master Fencing Fox application.

To create one, click on the plus sign.



6.1 PROPERTIES OF A PAGE CARROUSEL

Let's choose **Participants** as an example. When requested, select the desired competition.



On the right panel, properties can be customized.

The checkboxes (Club, etc.) allow to select which information will be displayed for each fencer.

It is possible to adjust **the font size** for text and title separately, here 20 and 24 respectively. The buttons allow respectively to increase and decrease the font size for the text or the title. The logo size is 4 times the title font size. **Number of lines per screen** allows to adapt how many names will be displayed per page, according to screen extent and font size.

Fo real time results, such as poule scores coming from smartphones or scoring devices, the data will be immediately updated without waiting for the window refresh.

6.2 ADDING OR REMOVING A COMPETITION

If a competition is added or deleted in Fencing Fox, it will added or deleted in the tabs on adding a new screen.

6.3 SELECTING LAYOUT

The coordinates are written as x@y.

The diaporama may handled several screens, only one screen will have origin 0@0. Other screens may have negative origin if extended to the right or the left of the mainscreen.

By default the extent is the selected screen extent.

There are several possible layouts :



- 1 : Full screen
- 2V : Screen split in 2 parts aligned vertically
- 2H: Screen split in 2 parts aligned horizontally
- 3H: Screen split in 3 parts aligned horizontally
- 2/3V : 2 /3 of the screen in upper part (used with another 3V)
- 3V : Screen split in 3 parts aligned vertically

- 3H : Screen split in 3 parts aligned horizontally ٠
- 4 : Screen split in 4 parts
- Screen split in 6 parts

Panel :

Each layout defines a number of panels and the page carrousel may be displayed in any panel. The panels are numbered from left to right then from top to bottom.



The command bar allows to operate pages.

The delay expressed in seconds, is the interval between display of each page in the carrousel.

Launches multiplexed pages: for instance, if you multiplex participants lists of 2 competitions, the diaporama will display page 1 of the first list, then page 1 of the second, page 2 of the first, page 2 of the second, etc.

6.5 PREVIEWING A PAGE

The preview icon toggles between display/hide of the selected page preview.

The preview will be displayed in the left part of the window, to allow playing with the page parameters in an interactive fashion.

The page will get a checked box under the "mapped" column.

6.7 MONITORING OPENED WINDOWS

By clicking on the **Running** tab, you can monitor launched screens.

6.7.1 WORKING WITH MULTIPLEXED DISPLAYS



Here, the first screen (1) is split in 4 (4) parts and the first panel (1/4/1) displays alternatively the list of participants and the poules of competition SH.

The second panel (1/4/2) displays participants and poules of SD.

You can expand or collapse each element of the tree view, which is a multiplex.

It is possible to add or remove items in a multiplex by selecting it and clicking on the plus and minus button.

6.7.2 MULTIPLEX OPERATIONS



It is also possible to modify the refreshing rate, but you need to restart the multiplex.

The **Test photos** button allow to test locally the photos.

Use the arrows back and forth to scroll through fencers.

The photos will be resized automatically to the window height.



7.6 PISTES

It is possible to display results from matches on a piste, possibly in a multiplex mode.

If the match uses a connected machine or smartphone phone score input, the results will be displayed in real time (1/10th s).

7.6.1 PREPARING IN FENCING FOX

Select the "Packets" option when starting the Diaporama service in the Fox software.

Autonomous : decides who receives the scoring device messages. The window is not autonomous if the messages are received through smartphones, of it the diaporama is embedded.
